Jason Mraz & Colbie Caillat General Information



Mraz, whose name means "frost" in Czechoslovakian, grew up in Mechanicsville, Virginia. As a child, he heard a great deal of pop music. As he grew older he became interested in hip-hop and dance music. When he was in high school he realized he could write songs that told stories, and then sing them. He began singing in a local band, Dressed to Kill. After graduating from high school, Mraz went to New York City to study musical theater at the American Musical and Dramatic Academy

He released his debut album, Waiting for My Rocket to Come, in 2003.



Caillat was born in Malibu, California. When she was an infant, her parents gave her the nickname "Coco", which she would later name her debut álbum released in 2007. Caillat took piano lessons as a child, but lacked significant inspiration until she turned 11 years old, when she became enthralled with Lauryn Hill's performance in Sister Act 2. She realized that she wanted to be a singer, and began taking vocal lessons, performing onstage for the first time in sixth grade. Caillat's second album, Breakthrough, was released in August 2009.

'Lucky' is a song by Jason Mraz and Colbie Caillat. It is the third single from Mraz's third studio album. Mraz and Caillat won the 2010 Grammy Award ofr Best Pop Collaboration with Vocals.

Mraz became a fan of Caillat after hearing her music on MySpace. He then called her to see if she would want to write and sing together.

The video was shot in Prague and an island in Hawaii and was released in 2009. Mraz and Caillat's parts in the video were filmed separately. The video follows the context of the song, featuring Mraz and Caillat singing their verses.
